Ladies and Gentlemen: With a total population of nearly 86 million, Vietnam is the third most populous country in Southeast Asia (after Philippines and Indonesia) and the thirteenth most populous country in the world. It is therefore seen as a potential and attractive market. Textile and garment is one of the spearhead industries of the country with export revenue is considerable relative to other industries of Vietnam in general and HCMC in particular.

Being economic centre of the entire country and a vibrant city, HCMC authority always supports and creates favourable conditions for enterprises to invest and to do business in the city, especially in their process to integrate into the global economy.

Despite difficulties the world economy facing in 2009, HCMC authority has adopted measures appropriate and effective measures. Therefore, with stable social political environment, the business environment of the city has greatly improved. This has facilitated plans of enterprises concerning their investment, production and export activities. Markets for the city's exports have now expanded to 224 countries and territories (compared to that of 210 in 2008). In the first three months of 2010, the city's GDP has a growth rate of 11 percent, export revenue (excluding crude oil and gold) increase by 16.7 percent (2.2 percent higher than that of the same period in 2009). Export revenue of textile and garment industry of the city reached 414.4 million US dollars, 13.3 percent higher than that of the same period last year. It is worth noting that a lot of companies have received enough orders to produce till the end of the year. Value of industrial products increases by 13.7 percent (which is 7.2 times higher than that of the same period in 2009).

Over the past years, although facing a lot of difficulties, the textile and garment industry has making a great deal of efforts, which has been paid off. The industry's products have gain trust of consumers and were displayed at the Vietnam Fashion Fair. As far as I know, at this event there is a fashion gala show. This is a good opportunity for the industry to develop its name through various marketing channels.

I believe that this exhibition will provide the industry's enterprises with advanced technology and machinery, which facilitate them to produce high quality products and to have more independent sources of accessories.
